If the remaining balance of \$ _____ is not paid at 8 weeks of age/or notification of pups availability, seller may offer said puppy to another buyer without any further obligation to buyer placing this deposit. If prior arrangements are made and you send a check it needs a minimum of 10 days to clear prior to pickup of any puppy **(Make check payable to Natalie Denton)**

* This deposit can be moved to another litter but if deposits on said litter have already been received it will go behind those deposits.

* Seller always gets first pick of any litter.

* Preferred method of deposit is a check or through or Zelle to akgoldrush@yahoo.com.

* Puppies need to be picked up at 8 weeks of age unless other arrangements have been made with seller or it's in the best interest for the puppy to stay with seller a little longer.

* Pricing on shipping can change due to airlines fees and buyer is responsible for all fees associate with shipping of puppy, including purchase of crate and health certificate for shipping.

* Seller has the right of refusal on any puppy for any given reason. (Usually only happens if I realize puppy is being bought to resale or if I am notified that buyer wouldn't be able to give the puppy a good home)

Congratulations on your decision to make an A&K Gold Rush Retriever puppy a special part of your life! While getting a new puppy can be one of the most exciting experiences a family can have, A&K Gold Rush Retrievers is committed to making the journey as rewarding and stress-free as possible for both you and your puppy. To begin, we will keep you up to date with information about your puppy through our Facebook page as it grows until it is time for your puppy to go to your home. As a member of the A&K Gold Rush Retrievers Family, we'd love for you to keep in touch. Please feel free to email, text or call us with any questions, concerns, or stories you might have to share.

Below you will find our Health Guarantee which was written in the best interest of the breeder and buyer and, most importantly, to protect the health and well-being of the puppy.

BREEDER AGREES:

- The puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of sale.
- The puppy will be up to date on shots and worming at the time of pick up.
- The puppy will have a veterinarian health check and deemed in good health prior to the completion of the sale and rehoming of the puppy.
- At the time of sale, this dog/puppy is considered and being sold as pet quality.
- Breeder offers NO guarantee that disqualifying faults will not arise or develop that would make this puppy unsuitable for the show ring and/or breeding.
- The breeder can NOT assume responsibility for this puppy after 48 hours of the release of the puppy to the buyer or the buyer's transport. It is the responsibility of the buyer to care for the puppy properly and keep it free from harm. Please remember that your puppy must be treated with great care and protected from danger.
- The breeder assumes NO responsibility for any medical expenses incurred after the sale.
- The breeder gives a one year guarantee against any congenital defects of the puppy. If this should occur then the puppy will be returned to the breeder, and will receive another puppy of the same breed when one becomes available.

BUYER AGREES:

- Buyer understands puppy could live 10+ years.
- Puppy must be paid in full prior to pick up unless other arrangements are made.
- The buyer agrees to have the puppy inspected by a licensed veterinarian within 48 hours of receiving puppy. If within 48 hours, a licensed veterinarian deems the puppy to

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be unhealthy or unfit for sale, the puppy may be returned for a replacement puppy provided the puppy has not been injured or neglected. The veterinarian must provide a written statement deeming the puppy “unhealthy for purchase,” which shall be reviewed by the A&K Gold Rush Retrievers veterinarian. Both veterinarians must agree with the other before a replacement puppy can be provided.

- Documentation from the first vet visit to confirm health upon arrival must be sent to the breeder within ten days in order for the Health Guarantee to be honored. If not, the buyer by default agrees to accept the A&K Gold Rush Retriever’s veterinarian health check prior to departure.
- If routine health care, including age and location of appropriate immunizations and deworming, is not provided to ensure the safety and health of the puppy, the health guarantee and/or replacement of the puppy will be terminated and deemed void. It is very important that you maintain a vaccination and deworming protocol as determined by your veterinarian. Please do not expose your puppy to other dogs that are not vaccinated until he/she has completed the entire vaccination schedule (around 16-20 weeks of age).
- All vet bills are the responsibility of the buyer after delivery.
- If this dog is used for breeding, even accidental, it voids all guarantees or agreements, written or verbal, unless other arrangements were made between buyer and seller.
- Breeder should be notified if buyer can no longer care for the puppy. The puppy will need to be returned to the breeder at no cost to the breeder.
- Before this puppy can be transferred to a third party the breeder must be notified.
- This contract applies to the original buyer only and is non-transferable to a second party.
- Buyer agrees to inform breeder of any health issues that might arise in said puppy so breeder can work to eliminate them from the breed.
- If the puppy should pass away for any reason in the first year an autopsy **MUST** be performed at buyers expense and results forwarded to breeder within 15 days if buyer wants a replacement puppy.
- This guarantee does **NOT** cover any health issues caused by neglect or injury from the buyer.
- This guarantee does **NOT** include minor illnesses and health issues such as colds, allergies, internal or external parasites or hernias.
- If the seller incurs any vet bills due to the condition the puppy is returned in, those fees will need to be paid to the seller and if poor condition of puppy there will **NOT** be a replacement or a refund for said puppy.

TERMS OF REPLACEMENT:

48 Hour Health Guarantee / 1 year Replacement Guarantee

• It will be up to us, the breeders, to decide when the puppy will be ready to go to its new home. This is usually at the age of eight weeks. Vaccines will be given at 6 weeks (which is what our vet suggests, i.e., to give the first shot 2 weeks prior to leaving at 8 weeks to help build immunity before going their new home.)

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- This puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of pickup.
- If the puppy is found to be in unacceptable health, a written statement from the veterinarian should be forwarded to the seller and the puppy should be returned within 48 hours (at buyer's expense) for a replacement.
- If the above dog should develop a severe genetic disease before its 1st birthday and can no longer function as a Pet/Companion Animal the breeder will replace at no charge with a comparable puppy. The dog will be replaced either from the same litter or from a future litter. A proper letter from the vet stating the problem found and the vet's opinion on the viability of the animal must be sent to the seller within 15 days of diagnosis. The seller will have the final say on whether the original puppy must be returned or not. All the vet bills and returned shipping fees are the responsibility of the buyer and will NOT be accepted by the breeder.

This guarantee does NOT include uneven bites, un-dropped testicles, umbilical hernia unable to produce puppies or show quality. Unless otherwise specified, all vet bills for corrective surgery, cosmetic surgery, shots and normal health care, euthanasia, spay/neuter and also shipping are the responsibility of the buyer.

Preventing Hip Dysplasia

DON'T overfeed your puppy, no matter how hungry they seem. Overweight increases pressure on the hip joints. Rapid growth means hip joint may not develop properly. Do NOT over exercise your puppy. Once your puppy is grown they need regular exercise or that can affect their joints as well.

Avoiding high impact activities like jumping, stairs and jogging until the growth plates have closed.

Keep puppy on a good quality feed and diet
